A few weeks ago we held our 11th annual Washington DC Summit and sent a strong message to our nation's leaders that America must always stand with Israel. Thousands of Christians from all denominational and ethnic backgrounds came together in our capital city to speak with one voice and extend the hand of friendship and brotherhood to Israel and the Jewish people. For a full decade now, CUFI has championed the deep and eternal bond Christians have with Israel, and we could not do it without the generosity of people like you.

This summer we have seen a dramatic rise in terrorism across the globe, and as always Israel is on the front lines of the battle between good and evil. Their enemies are our enemies. When a 13 year old Jewish girl, an Israeli-American dual citizen, was murdered in her bed we all wept with her family. Sadly, this type of brutal and unwarranted attack against innocent Israelis is the direct result of the Palestinian leadership's support for violence. This is the reality Israelis live with on a daily basis. To add insult to injury, most of the world turns a blind eye to the terrorism and instead chooses to condemn Israel's response to it.

The hatred that murders Israelis is the same hatred that murdered hundreds of innocents in Brussels, Orlando, Istanbul, and Baghdad this year alone. This summer has been packed with exciting developments. Our regional coordinators are zigzagging the country, stirring up support for Israel and forging new relationships. In Reno, a reunion of CUFI pastors met with Lieutenant Governor Mark Hutchison and heard about his deep love for Israel and his commitment to fighting the BDS movement in Nevada. Our BDS task force coordinator recently received an emergency request for help from Hillel International when the Unitarian Universalist General Assembly scheduled a last-minute vote on divestment from Israel. CUFI's quick response helped defeat the BDS resolution that same evening.

We took retired IDF Colonel Dan Tirza on a tour of eight cities in the Western Region, where he captivated hundreds of people with stories of how Israel worked hard to balance the need for a security fence with compassion and respect for the Palestinian people. In late June and early July, CUFI held 15 events across the country in addition to the DC
